

15<sup>th</sup> POPOLI E RELIGIONI – TERNI FILM FESTIVAL  
- FEATURE FILMS AND DOCUMENTARIES –

The 15<sup>th</sup> edition of the Terni Film Festival “Popoli e Religioni”, taking place from 9<sup>th</sup> to 17<sup>th</sup> November 2019, organized by Istess, announces a competition for films focused on the theme “First man”.

Registration for the contest is completely free, open to everybody around the world.  
In order to participate, you have to choose between:

- Sending your works to “Film Festival Popoli e Religioni c/o Istess Cenacolo San Marco, via del Leone, 12 – 05100 Terni.
- Sending your works by e-mail, attaching them, to [redazione.popoliereligioni@gmail.com](mailto:redazione.popoliereligioni@gmail.com)
- Sending your works by FilmFreeway

The application shall be submitted no later than 31<sup>st</sup> of August 2019 (the stamped postal date being decisive). The format of the works must be exclusively in DCP or in file HD MP4, or DVD; otherwise the work will be disqualified.

Films could be of the following genre: feature, documentary or animation.

All films must be available in Italian or English.

The main subject of the Festival, which will celebrate the 50th anniversary of the moon landing, is “First Man” in all its meanings (with regards to discoveries, social progress etc.), including its anthropological, spiritual and religious implications; other topics shall relate to spirituality, inter-religious relationships, volunteering and immigration.

For each submitted work, participants have to attach a signed entry form, indicating of the film's title and the pressbook of the work. The material sent for the section will not be returned and will become the property of the Organization. The selected works will be screened in DVD, DCP or in HD MP4 file formats.

The results of the film selection will be communicated by e-mail or phone, in order to allow the selected authors to attend the awards ceremony at the Cinema Politeama in Terni.

The jury will be composed of journalist, critics and personalities from the film and entertainment industry.

The winner of the feature film and the winner of documentary categories will be awarded the “Angel” – statue created by Fernando Dominioni. A special jury will be composed of members of SIGNIS and will grant the Signis Awards for the best film and the special mention for the documentary.
